### Call for Proposals

The Food Justice Summit brings together leaders, changemakers, and stakeholders from across the region to address key issues within the food system. Inspired by previous conversations, this year's event focuses on collective action and solutions to creating and sustaining NY products and agriculture. We aim to highlight the challenges within the sectors of the food system and bring the collective expertise and wisdom to create a recipe for a resilient food system.

We invite submissions that showcase creative and collaborative approaches to solving problems in the following four components of the food system:



#### GROWERS

**Growers:** Highlighting innovative farming techniques, sustainable practices, and strategies to support the health and well-being of farmers and agricultural workers.



#### PRODUCERS

**Producers:** Exploring opportunities for value-added production, local food processing innovations, and the development of resilient food production systems.



#### DISTRIBUTORS

**Distributors:** Addressing challenges and solutions related to local food distribution, logistics, and ensuring equitable access to regional markets.



#### MARKETS

**Markets:** Strategies for strengthening local food markets, farm-to-institution programs, and expanding opportunities for consumers to access fresh, nutritious, and locally produced food.
